Awards for all – up to £10k per organisation including schools Only 4 voluntary sector organisations in the area have had grants 4 successful charity awards 3 of those to Scrapstore(2011 /2014 & 2016) – and 1 to TWIG/Olive tree (2011) 5 schools awards

What would be really helpful is to have a document about social need for the Parish? What are the priorities for the area?
