348 **Parking at Rodbourne Farm Leisure Garden**
The Deputy Clerk informed the Committee that the Project Manager was still to visit the Rodbourne Farm Leisure Garden to look at the options for parking and an update would be provided at a future meeting.

349 **Update from Deputy Clerk**
Allotments
The Deputy Clerk informed the Committee that invoices were being sent out for the 18/19 billing year.
All Build Ltd had been contracted to install mains water at the Somerford Close Leisure Garden and install a ramp for the composting toilet the Pickards Field Leisure Garden site, as agreed at the meeting held in December 2018, and works should start imminently.

Bus Shelters

It was confirmed that bus shelters had been installed on Whitworth Road and outside the Dolphin. A new shelter had been purchased to be installed on Pinehurst Road and this should be in place towards the end of January 2019.

Cllr M Lucas informed the Committee that at the Finance and Staffing Committee meeting held the previous evening it had been agreed that transparent transfers displaying the Parish Council name be installed on the new bus shelters purchased.

Cllr J Ballman stated his support for the notion.

Noticeboards

The Deputy Clerk informed the Committee that Swindon Borough Council had come back with several queries on the 4 planning applications submitted. Responses to some of the queries had been provided whilst others were referred to the Noticeboard Company and the Deputy Clerk was awaiting responses.

Cllr D Moffatt informed the Committee that 1 member of the public had objected to the transfer of assets in response to details of the transfers being published in the paper and that this could delay the transfers by approx. 1 month. He went on to explain the process which now had to be followed by Swindon Borough Council.
