### **EP127**      **Litter Bins**

- a) **East side of Cheney Manor Road** – A litter bin was requested by a member of the public. The Chair and Estates Manager will look into this using the Parishes Litter Bin Policy. Members also noted the surrounding overgrowth. The Chair will raise the matter of overgrowth with Idverde.
  
- b) **Relocation of bin situated at the end of Church Walk South** – The relocation of the bin was requested by a member of the public. The Chair and Estates Manager will look into the logistics and costs associated with relocating this bin whilst also considering the proximity to the next litter bin.
